Instructions for the Final Presentation/Speech Prof. Kazuhiko YOSHIDA, PhD School of International Studies, Utsunomiya University

Those students who wish to obtain credits of the class are supposed to deliver an individual presentation on Zoom in the final week class on February 4, 2022. Here are the conditions for that:

 The topic of your presentation will be either "What makes sustainability meaningful to me" (私にとって持続可能性が持つ意義 とは) or "What makes SDGs meaningful to me" (私にとって SDGs が 持つ意義とは). Your presentation contents must be made based on your participation in the 6 professors' lectures/sessions.

• Your presentation must be within 3 minutes and entirely in English.

• A 3-minute speech in English usually consists of 340 to 420 words. Please make a draft and practice talking with a watch. You do not need to learn the whole thing of your draft by heart. However, please try to speak it to the audience as much as you can rather than to read it.

• You can show a couple of pictures, charts or PowerPoint slides by sharing your screen while you are speaking. If you use such things, it is preferable to submit the files for sure by the previous day Feb. 3, 2022 to "SLIDES FOR FEB.4" of the function  $\vee \pi - \wedge$  of the C-learning class.

• In your presentation, please distinguish an opinion from a fact and vice versa. Please specify the information source. Notably please clarify which professor's lecture/session you have learned from.

• During the presentation, please use video to show yourself, if you think that that is socially expected. Actually, eye contact is often essential in English communication. Your eyes talk as much as your mouth does. Of course, no one would force you to do that, though.
